PLEASE NOTE:

Gear Checks will be limited to 15 minutes please keep this in mind when entering classes as the Gate will not be held up if you are not ready for your next nominated class.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Led 2 years old horses cannot compete in ridden events and vice versa;
- Only horses aged 3 years and over can compete in Ranch Riding;
- GDWPC reserves the right to change, alter or amend the program at any time;
- GDWPC reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor;
- Beginner/Improvers are encouraged to participate in GDWPC Walk/Trot, Walk/Jog under A Show Program;
- Beginner Rider definition – any rider (non-pro) that has not won 6 blue ribbons with three or more in the class. If you compete in Beginner Classes at a Show then you must continue to compete in beginner classes except for Club Classes Only, if offered.
- Beginner Horse definition - any horse that has not won 6 blue ribbons with three or more in the class. This class is opened to any classification of Rider. If you compete in Beginner Classes at a Show then you must continue to compete in beginner classes except for Club Classes Only on that particular horse.
- Beginner Classes Horses can be ridden in either a snaffle or curb bit and two handed if required.
- Member Only Classes can be ridden either one or two handed but all gear must be legal to participate in these classes you must be a current financial member of GDWPC.
- Participants by entering this event are giving permission to GDWPC to use any and all images for promotional purposes. Images will be available to all entrants after the event has concluded and must contact the photographer directly.
- Judges' decision is final, any protests must go through AQHA Ruling;
- Back Numbers are allocated per horse and must be displayed when competing – NO back number or INCORRECT back number means no placing;
- GDWPC will take no responsibility for any loss, damage or theft to any persons/horses, vehicles or property whilst at these shows. All competitors compete at their own risk;
- Lead Line Competitors must be 3-6 years of age and must be wearing an approved helmet. Stirrups must be short enough for their legs OR stirrup buddies can be used. A bridle and halter are to be used. Tiny Tots walk/jog competitors must be aged 5-10 years.
- Classes marked with * are non-point scoring events;
- GDWPC requires all horse registrations and current membership cards for show year submitted with nominations. All copies will be retained by the Club for the show year as recommended by AQHA.
- Prize Money/Prizes at a AA Show will be on yellow boxed classes only, Prize Money is paid out 1st place only if less than 3 competitors or full prize pool 1st, 2nd, 3rd if more than three riders.

GDWPC Club Rules:

All competitors shall ensure good hygiene practices are maintained during the event, competitors will ensure all tack is clean on arrival and again cleaned prior to leaving the event and that any illness is reported immediately to the Show Office and shall immediate leave the event.

No illegal equipment or training aids permitted in marshalling area or arena within 1 hour of show or 1 hour after show.

Any unaccompanied youth must have the correct AQHA form filled out prior to the event.

Dress Regulations of Cap/Hat, long style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves must be worn if entering the ring.

Amateur/Select/Master Amateur Cards must be shown when nominating.

Members Only Halter Horses must be registered with their associations and proof provided when nominating.

All halter horses must be registered with their appropriate association and a copy need to be provided to the show secretary prior to commencement of show. A copy of the registration papers will be held by GDWPC for audit purposes.

All performance horses must be registered with their appropriate breed associations and a copy of the registration must be submitted with the nominations.

ALL dogs must be on leash and controlled by the owners AT ALL TIMES.

Exhibitors shall not approach the Judge for any reason prior to completion of the judging, unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request is made through the ring steward or gate marshal only.

Code of Conduct

Competitors/participants at any event run by Gunalda & Districts Western Performance Club Inc have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the Gunalda & Districts Western Performance Inc and the AQHA at all times. Competitors/Participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

No alcohol in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest area.

All Youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.
